Main business: a producer of blending and bagging systems. EMT produces machines in its own factory in Holland. Qualified EMT technicians install these machines at various locations throughout the world, such as in fertilizer production facilities, at fertilizer dealerships and in local fertilizer/dockside warehouses. The machines are of modular construction and can be transported in closed containers.

Product range: a wide range of bagging and blending equipment plus associated in-line transportation equipment, such as conveyors, for use within the fertilizer industry. FIBC filling machines available from the company include the Triple Container, the High Speed Twin, the Basic, the High Speed, the Economic, the Low Profile and the Junior, with capacities varying from 30 till 240 big bags per hour. Smaller bag filling lines include the Small Bag Single Unit, the Small Bag Double Unit, the Small Bag Container, the Small Bag Compact, the Small Bag Gross Nett and the Small Bag Environmental, with capacities varying from 0 till 45 ton per hour per unit. The bagging lines are very flexible: the Combi machine, for example, can be used to fill both FIBCs and smaller bags of 25 to 50 kg. In addition, EMT can supply

bag-closing equipment, such as sealing, sewing or valve systems. EMT also offers a wide range of bulk blending equipment, including the Weighcont Blender and the Doyle product range (the Shamrock Vertical Blender, the Kraus, Smithbuilt and Tower Blender lines). Bagging line references: available upon request from EMT. The company has installed over 400 blender and bagging lines in recent years to customers worldwide.

New product development: a recent development is the production of portable container bagging stations for use wherever required by the customer. The latest additions to this product line are the Triple Big Bag Line High Speed, which has a capacity of 120 tph, a 60 tph variant of this equipment and the Small Bag 25-50 kg Container Double unit bagging line with a capacity of 40 or 80 tph. These containerized systems are easy to install and can be relocated using regular forklifts, trucks and container ships.

Recent award: In May 2011, EMT received an innovation award for the company's container bagging unit at the Victam Exhibition in Cologne, Germany.
